

# LiVista Rescup 0.0.1

## **Preparation**

- Open this PDF with Adobe Reader 8 or above (on Linux you can alternatively use the `pdftk` tool).
- Open the Attachment Tab on the bottom, if not there already
- Save `rescup.bat` (extract `rescup.txt` and rename it) and `rescup.dat` onto the root of a floppy or USB key or another medium that is readably by your „problem“ PC. Do not save them into a directory if you are not used to using the Windows Command Prompt.
- Print these instructions, if needed.

## **Using**

- Boot Windows Vista Setup. When using an USB key, attach the USB key before booting the setup.
- Confirm the first two dialogs, the one of the pre-setup wizard
- The background changes color and the product key dialog appears
- Now press Shift+F10
- When using a floppy, insert the floppy now and enter `a:\rescup` at the prompt.
- When using an USB key, enter notepad at the prompt. Use File→Open to find the drive letter of your USB key. Then run `L:\rescup` at the prompt (replace the drive letter appropriately)
- Wait until you see the task bar appear
- Close the setup window. The pre-setup window will appear again. ***Do not close this one!***
- You can now load an explorer by selecting “Computer” from the start menu.
- You can also run any portable apps you have on your USB key.
- When finished with using the rescue system, close the pre-setup window and your PC will reboot.
